Learn to make a Japanese Yukata, an unlined summer Kimono. People wearing yukata are a common sight in Japan at fireworks displays, bon-odori festivals, and other summer events.

We'll tailor a pattern specifically for your body, make a custom yukata and obi, and learn how to tie and wear them both. In the first class, students will learn about fabric pattern and measurements so that they can select and purchase their own fabric for their project. Other supplies will be provided.
